

COOKIES AND STATISTICS POLICY

Please read the following carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it.

The information we collect about you

We collect many types of information from and about users of our Site, including, for example:

- information we collect when you browse our Site, including IP addresses, cookies and web beacons;
- name and surname, contact details, bank details, records and copies of correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us and access GuardianAngel.NET services online

Usage details, IP addresses, cookies and other technologies

- **Usage details and IP addresses.** We may collect statistical information about the equipment, actions and browsing patterns of users of our Site. This information derives from your visit and navigation on the Site. The information may include, for example:
 - o traffic, log data and other communication data;
 - o information about the resources you access;
 - o information about your computer and Internet connection (for example, including your IP address, operating system and browser type), for system administration.
- **Cookies.** We may obtain information about your general internet usage by using cookies. A cookie is a small file stored on your computer's hard drive. The use of cookies helps us improve our Site and provide a better and more personalized service, which allows us to:
 - estimate audience size and usage patterns;
 - we store information about your preferences, which allows us to customize our Site according to your individual interests;
 - to recognize you when you return to our Site.

You can refuse to accept cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. If you select this setting, you may not be able to access certain parts of our Site. If you have not

adjusted your browser setting to refuse cookies, your system will continue to accept cookies when you direct your browser to our Site.

• **Web beacons.** Some pages of the Site may contain electronic images known as web beacons (also called single pixel gifs). Web beacons allow the Company to collect certain information about users of the Site, including, for example, the number of users who access each web page, traffic data, log data and other communication data, information related to access to resources and information about the user's computer and Internet connection (including IP addresses, operating systems and browser type). Web beacons are not used to access your personal information on the Site, but are used only to compile aggregate statistics regarding the use of the Site and to verify system and server integrity.

Use of information

We use the information we collect about you for the following purposes:

- to present our Site and its content in a manner that is appropriate and effective for you and your computer;
- to provide you with the information you request from us;
- to inform you about our new services and products, or about changes to them, including direct marketing;
- compilation of user statistics;
- the security and improvement of our Site.

Disclosure of your information

We may disclose the information we obtain through this Site to third parties to:

- to comply with a court order or other legal obligation;
- execute a contract, request or enforce our terms of use and other agreements;
- to protect the rights and assets of the company and its affiliates. This includes sharing information for the purposes of fraud protection and fraud risk reduction.

The rights you benefit from in connection with the processing of your data are the following:

- the possibility to obtain from the company, upon request and free of charge, confirmation that your personal data is being processed by us, as well as details related to this processing.
- the right to rectify, update, block or transform into anonymous data the data whose processing is not in accordance with the law, especially incomplete or inaccurate data;
- the right to object at any time, for well-founded and legitimate reasons related to your particular situation, to the processing of your personal data;

- the right to object free of charge and without any justification to the processing of your personal data for direct marketing, on behalf of the data controller or on behalf of a third party, or to disclose your data for this purpose;
- the right to contest decisions taken exclusively on the basis of data processing carried out by automated means and which produce legal consequences in respect of you.

To exercise these rights, you can submit a signed and dated request to the following email address: **office.ganet@gmail.com**

- the right to file a complaint with ANSPDCP, in the situation where you believe that the company has affected your rights provided by law.
- the right to go to court, if you believe that the company has violated your rights provided by law.

Duration of storage

We will keep your personal data for a period of time necessary for the purposes indicated in the "Use of information" section, but no longer than 2 years. After the data is no longer needed for these purposes, it will be:

- destroyed;
- transferred to another personal data operator, provided that the personal data is processed within limits and purposes similar to those initially agreed or
- transformed into anonymous data and kept exclusively for statistical, historical or scientific research purposes.

It is our policy to post any changes we make on this page. To the extent that we make material changes to this document, in particular with respect to the processing of your data, we will ask you to renew your agreement to these Terms of Use before those changes take effect.
